





Egypt post cards. Late 19th century: Camels and Pyramids.










China. The Kashag Historical Archives of Tibet: The letter of Mao Zedong to the 14th Dalai Lama.







Selection Criteria












Essential Steps

- Digitise, describe, annotate, translate bibliographical descriptions, or even full texts.
- Ad hoc training.
- Wide dissemination of resultant product.










