Preservation Challenges

- **MEDIUM**
 - STORAGE MEDIA NATURALLY DECAY
- **TECHNOLOGICAL (E.G. HARDWARE/SOFTWARE)**
 - HARDWARE AND SOFTWARE OBSOLESCENCE MAKES DATA/INFORMATION INACCESSIBLE
- **INTELLECTUAL**
 - VALIDATION OF INTEGRITY AND AUTHENTICITY
- **CONTEXTUAL**
 - AVOID LOSS OF MEANING WITH METADATA
- **LEGAL IMPEDIMENTS**
 - DATA PROTECTION, FOI
